O R D E R

As per reference read (i) above the Government of Kerala had issued No Objection Certificates to 75 (Seventy five) agencies to start unaided Training Colleges in the State from 2004-05 subject to recognition by the National Council for Teacher Education and affiliation by the Universities concerned. As per reference cited (ii) above the NCTE have granted recognition to Porukara College of Education, Gagultha Monastery's Campus, Champakulam, Alappuzha District, PIN - 688505, Kerala under the Management of Mount Tabor Educational Charitable Society to offer B.Ed. degree course on self-financing basis during the academic year 2004-05. The Kerala Government vide G.O. read (iii) above have granted permissive sanction for starting B.Ed course in the above institution from the year 2005-06.

The matter has been considered by the University and sanction has been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor, subject to ratification by the Syndicate, to grant provisional affiliation to Porukara College of Education, Gagultha Monastery's Campus, Champakulam, Alappuzha District, PIN - 688505, Kerala, to run B.Ed. course on self-financing basis during the academic year 2005-06 with an annual intake of 100 seats.

The provisional affiliation granted is initially for a period of one year with the following optional subjects:

- (1) English (2) Commerce (3) Mathematics (4) Social Studies
